- Family Accountability (1 Cor. 5, Rev. 2)

I never liked group projects at school because it seemed like there would always be one or two goof balls who would not do any work. Either the rest carried them and passed or the entire group suffered.

But, as a teacher I now understand the value and importance of group assignments.

The idea is to encourage community
